

Haiku/Canto Functionality

- ▶ View patient lists
- ▶ Review patient information, such as problem list, medications, allergies, immunizations, history, demographics, pharmacy
- ▶ Request push notification for labs and imaging
- ▶ Review/download cardiology studies (Canto only)
- ▶ Mark results notes as important
- ▶ Place IP/OP medication and procedure orders (Canto only)
- ▶ Place OP medication order (Haiku only)
- ▶ Update preferred pharmacy association
- ▶ Capture clinical images and save directly to patient chart
- ▶ E-prescribe Ambulatory non-controlled medications in Haiku and Canto
- ▶ View IP Handoff reports in Haiku and view/edit handoff reports in Canto
- ▶ View results for labs, EKGs, imaging and procedures in results activity
- ▶ Enter notes using Dragon Speech-to-Text integration functionality
- ▶ View status board and allow completion of attestations (Anesthesia)
- ▶ View In Basket messages (patient calls, medical messaging, results, RX request, staff messages, co-sign [clinic orders only]) and release results to MyChart

Haiku and Canto

Haiku and Canto are applications providers may use to access Excellian on the go from a personal Smart Phone (Haiku) or your personal tablet (Canto - iPad only). Access to a cellular network or a WiFi connection is required.

- View notes in progress
- Enter notes using Dragon integration functionality
- Release results to MyChart

Preparing you Smart Device to utilize Haiku/Canto

The Haiku and Canto applications for personal smart devices which provides access to Excellian, can now be installed using a self-service website. You must first download the Haiku or Canto application from the appropriate application store.

Step-by-Step Instructions

- To utilize Haiku (smart phones) or Canto (iPad only) to access Excellian with a personal device, download the application from the Google Play Store (Android) or the Apple App Store. Minimum OS versions are as follows:
 - o iOS 9.0 or greater
 - o Android 4.1 or greater
- When installation of the appropriate application is complete, go to Allinahealth.org > For Medical Professionals or navigate to [www.allinahealth.org/haikucanto].
- Click the link for Haiku/Canto Device Setup. [www.allinahealth.org/haikucanto].
- Locate the Install ID for your device and paste it into the Install ID field on the web form. Fill in the remaining fields.

- Launch the application on your device and login with your Allina Health ID and network password.
