
- Create less confusion for all parties involved including hospitalists, ICU providers, CV surgery providers, and the patient access center

Summary

- H42-50 hospitalist pages APP HH1 for sign outs at 9 AM
- APP HH1 places transfer order when transfer is confirmed
- H42-50 hospitalist either takes these patients onto his/her service or gives them to other H5000 rounders
- H42-50 hospitalist informs Patient Access Center of new patients and number
- For transfers happening later in the day, APP HH1 pages H42-50 hospitalist and gives sign outs

· How to find AAP HH1 in amion:



- · Hospitalist do not attend the morning CV round in ICU
- CV APP SHOULD be attending the interdisciplinary rounds for the floor with CC, SW, and charge nurse and communicate the plan from CV surgery and discharge planning
 Patient Access Center is not involved in distributing these patients to decrease confusion
- Policy remains the same regardless of weekdays vs weekends
